

# Hazard and Risk Awareness

## RISK AWARENESS OVERVIEW:

This course has been designed to improve the skills and knowledge required to identify, assess, eliminate or control the safety risks of hazards in the workplace, via the use of appropriate risk assessment tools and documents in line with organisational procedures.

## LOCATIONS:

RTCSA delivers Hazard and Risk Awareness training, at worksites throughout regional South Australia, Victoria and New South Wales.

## COURSE DURATION:

This course can run from approximately 3-4 hours to a full 8-hour class dependent upon the needs of the client.

## COURSE CONTENT:

Assessment is based on theory questions as well as simulated practical scenarios and includes:

- An introduction to WHS acts, regulations, standards and codes of practice
- Hazard identification, potential consequences and risks to health and safety
- Hazard control and management, including elimination or minimisation of risk
- Workplace procedures
  - Job Safety Analysis (JSA)
  - Job Hazard Analysis (JHA)
  - Job Safety and Environmental Analysis (JSEA)
  - Safe Work Method Statements (SWMS)
- Monitoring and reviewing effectiveness of risk controls.

This course is delivered via blended training and contains both theoretical and practical elements.
